

2022 Field-of-Interest Grant Guidelines

The <u>Field-of-Interest</u> grant program is an annual grant opportunity made possible by Centre Foundation's Field-of-Interest funds. Each Field-of-Interest fund is designed to support a particular cause, population, or geographic area, reflecting the passions or interests of the donor(s) who created the fund.

This year, over \$139,000 in Field-of-Interest grant funding is available for programs and projects that focus on education, health and social services, music, youth development, and more.

Eligibility

- This opportunity is open to qualified 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations and governmental units/agencies.
- Funding must be used to support programs/projects in Centre County unless stated otherwise.
- Funding must be used to support programs/projects that comply with Centre Foundation's Nondiscrimination Policy.
- If awarded, funding from this grant must be spent by recipient organizations by December 31, 2023.
- Recipient organizations are required to submit a final grant report at the conclusion of the program/project or by January 31, 2024.

- Tuesday, September 6, 2022 Field-of-Interest online grant application opens.
- Thursday, October 20, 2022 at 11:59 pm Deadline to submit an application.
- Friday, December 16, 2022 Notification of grant awards.
- Before December 31, 2022 Grant payments issued. Grant period begins.
- Saturday, December 31, 2023 Grant period ends.
- Tuesday, January 31, 2024 Final grant reports are due.

Instructions

Centre Foundation's 16 Field-of-Interest funds each support a specific purpose and geographic area. Please see the table on the following page for each fund's purpose, service area, and available grant amount.

On the application, you will be required to identify the funds for which you are applying. You may apply for any portion of the available grant amount listed for a particular fund. You may combine several funds together if multiple funds fit the scope of your proposal. Please choose only those funds which directly relate to your proposal, based on the fund's stated purpose.

Applications must be submitted through <u>Foundant</u>, Centre Foundation's online application portal, by 11:59 pm on **Thursday**, **October 20**, **2022**. Please do not email, fax, physically mail, or hand-deliver your proposal. Application questions can be found at the end of this document.
